MISSION STATEMENT

The **Tupper Lake Fire Department**, under the directive of the Tupper Lake Mayor and Village Board of Trustees, and in partnership with the Town of Tupper Lake, has committed to a detailed process of assessing, without bias, the existing conditions at Tupper Lake Fire Station #1, and how the Station meets the needs of the Public and the Department.

The Committee consists of a representative cross section of all interested parties, including members from the Fire Department, Village Board, Town Board, community and other local officials, on an as-needed basis. HUEBER-BREUER has been retained and charged with facilitating the process.

The Committee will assess the Station's current condition, and consider how it will continue to meet the needs of Tupper Lake and the surrounding communities, including the ACR proposed project, for a minimum of the next 50 years. It will also fully explore the concept of a "multi-purpose" facility that would include Police and/or EMS Services. The goal of the study is to provide a fully developed, long range plan for fire/police/EMS services for Tupper Lake.

At the culmination of the study, the committee will present a complete Feasibility Study, and a proposed action plan for the Tupper Lake Village Board to review and act upon.
