Saturday's events all take place at the Tupper Lake Municipal Park. On Sunday the Warrior Run will be staged at Big Tupper.



Tupper Lake Revitalization Project Status Update June 2012

2008 Local Waterfront Program Grant EPF Project (\$195,000 Department of State)

(Funds the development of the Revitalization Strategy and Municipal Park playground and gateway improvements)

The Draft Revitalization Strategy was presented to the public on May 24th. Public comments and follow up publicity have been very positive. The Strategy has also been presented to the Village, Town, Planning and Zoning Boards for review and comment.

All comments will be provided to Behan Planning this week, and the Strategy will be finalized for Board adoption next month.

Municipal Park gateway and playground improvements:

- 1) The Village has signed and returned the \$35,000 Member Item contract from OPRHP for playground equipment purchase.
- 2) Melissa is working with DOS, Behan Planning and Design, and the Village Attorney to resolve Behan's concerns about out of scope construction phase tasks. More info to follow pending consultation with DOS and the Village Attorney.

Remaining Pre-Construction and Construction Tasks:

1. Obtain estimates from contractors – Village lead; in progress
2. Finalize budget and construction approach (DPW vs. contractor completion of tasks) - Village lead, with assistance from consultant
3. Finalize name for playground and decision on streetlights – Village lead; in progress
4. Finalize construction plans – Consultant, DOS approval
5. Execute construction easement with synagogue – Village lead; in progress
6. SEQR – Consultant prepares documents, Village conducts
7. SWIPP permit approval – pending from DEC
8. Issue requests for bid/quotes – Consultant prepares, Village issues
9. Award – Consultant reviews responses, provides recommendations to Village

10. Construction – Combination of Village DPW and contractor services, TBD
11. Construction Inspection and Administration – Village Clerk of the Works provides day to day supervision, consultant provides construction admin including approval of payment requests from contractors
12. Certify construction complete - Consultant

Brownfield Opportunity Area Grant

\$63,000 in Brownfield Opportunity Area funding for a feasibility analysis of redevelopment options for the Jarden/OWD/ shopping center site on Demars Boulevard and nearby parcels.

We are still waiting for a draft contract from DOS.

Wild Center Interpretive Displays for the Municipal Park

Project in progress, with installation of first phase of displays scheduled for completion this fall.

2011 Microenterprise Program Grant - \$200,000

Based upon a review of REI responses, the Village selected AEDC to administer the grant and provide project delivery services.

Jim Murphy of AEDC has outlined the project and is currently preparing a draft contract for services for the Village's review.

The next step will be for the Village Board to appoint a Program Review Committee to review applications from local businesses and award funding to those businesses that advance grant program goals. We would like to gather the Program Review Committee by the end of July and prepare for public outreach.

2011 Local Waterfront Program EPF Grant (DOS)

Andy Labruzzo from the Department of State met with Village representatives to review this grant contract, which includes funding for additional improvements in the municipal park and for revitalization project advancement. The grant contract has been signed by the Mayor and returned to the state for execution.

2012 Consolidated Funding Application/Regional Council Funding

I am currently developing an outline of Tupper Lake's 2012 application for Local Waterfront Program funding. The grant request will include additional funding for park improvements as well development of a marketing plan for the community, which was a key recommendation of the Revitalization Strategy.

The application will also include a partnership with ANCA on development of a regional Blueway marketing web site and mobile app for the 90 Miler route, with linkage to Tupper Lake's marketing materials. I am still working with project partners to develop the project and to assemble match.

The regional approach should strengthen our request; I believe it makes this application worthy of "Priority Project" consideration by the Regional Council. If we are successful in obtaining Priority Project status it will boost our funding chances and bring valuable publicity to Tupper's efforts. I will provide a preliminary outline for the Board's review this week.

I am also working with The Wild Center and the Adirondack Public Observatory to develop a priority project request for the 2012 funding round that includes all our individual grant requests.





Dear Mr. Bouck:

We are pleased to advise you that we anticipate there will be no reduction in firm hydro energy sales to our hydropower customers for the period of July 1 through 31, 2012. The forecasted July 2012 generation is projected to be sufficient to meet our firm hydropower customers' needs. However, if that generation is not sufficient, Substitute Energy will be purchased on your behalf for those customers with signed Substitute Energy agreements.

Since hydro shortfalls may still be anticipated in future months, we remain prepared to provide Substitute Energy to assure continuous flow of the lowest cost power to you. For those customers who have executed a Substitute Energy agreement, the Power Authority will automatically purchase the Substitute Energy on your behalf in months that a shortage occurs, pursuant to those agreements, unless otherwise notified. The monthly price for Substitute Energy is an average of all Substitute Energy provided to firm hydropower customers each month.

The Power Authority continues to be concerned about the river flows projected for 2012 - 2013. Current estimates are no shortage for August 2012 through January 2013. We will continue to analyze more current data monthly and provide this type of rolling 6-month forecast each month.
