## **Tupper Lake Seeking Public Input for Local Waterfront Revitalization Program**

Tupper Lake, N.Y. – The Village of Tupper Lake is preparing a Local Waterfront Revitalization Program (LWRP) in partnership with the New York State Department of State. The LWRP will explore how to develop the Village’s waterfront resources in a sustainable manner, enhance recreational opportunities, preserve historic architecture and redevelop underutilized properties.

Tupper Lake’s LWRP will define a vision for lands along Raquette Pond, The Junction, and Uptown. The LWRP will also help identify specific projects for future grant funding requests.

Examples of LWRP projects include:

- Park, recreation, and access improvements
- Beach enhancements
- Redevelopment of underused or deteriorated areas and sites
- Streetscape upgrades
- Trails and walkways
- Flood control
- Historic preservation
- Infrastructure enhancements

Mayor Paul Maroun notes: “We are excited to continue our longstanding partnership with the NYS Department of State Local Waterfront Revitalization Program. The LWRP process will help us identify projects

A virtual Open House survey will be open between November 24 and December 14 for residents to provide their thoughts on a variety of LWRP topics. The survey format allows each participant to share their opinions on each issue directly with the project team, and the Village hopes all interested residents and business owners will log on and weigh in.

For those who would prefer to provide their opinions in a meeting format, a Zoom Open House will be held on Tuesday, December 7<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 pm.
