On March 20, 2020 the Village and Town of Tupper Lake declared an emergency for the area. Pursuant to Executive Law the following Emergency Orders are put forward:


**Emergency Order #3**

As per the latest NYS Governor's proposals and Matilda's Law the following Emergency Orders are hereby put into effect:


- All non-essential businesses and services will be closed.
- All restaurants, diners and bars will not allow in-house dining.
- Restaurants will be allowed to provide take-out orders or provide delivery of orders.
- Bars will be allowed to sell take-outs or delivery but must meet the New York State Liquor Authority Guidelines.
- There will be not public gathers of any number of people.

The Code Enforcement Officers and Fire Chiefs will be checking for compliance and the Tupper Lake Police Department will provide enforcement for any violations.

These Emergency Orders will be in effect until April 16, 2020 at 10:00 am. These orders can be extended if needed. These orders can be rescinded by the Village and Town as necessary.
